

**City of Orangeburg and Orangeburg County
Community Development Block Grant Notice of Hearing
Concerning Program Performance and Accomplishments**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, April 21, 2026 at 3:00 pm., the City of Orangeburg and Orangeburg County will hold a public hearing to review program performance and accomplishments conducted under a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project known as Orangeburg DPU – Quicktown Area Water Upgrades (CDBG Project #4-CI-23-008). The City of Orangeburg used approximately \$2,035,870 in CDBG funds and \$1,766,113 of local funds for this project. This public hearing will be held at 352 Sprinkle Avenue, Orangeburg, SC 29116.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the City of Orangeburg Citizen Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and providing for the participation of the citizens of the City of Orangeburg in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds.
